

## RULES

**1.** The International Music Competition “**Città di Fasano**” is organized by International Music Academy “**Don Matteo Colucci**” with the support of **Fasano Administration**. The competition will take place in **Fasano** at the **Laboratorio Urbano** from **10<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> March 2019**. It is addressed at young musicians of both sexes and it is divided into 10 sections. The performance program is free except for the section “**Piano Performance**”.

**2.** Applications for registration should be sent by priority mail or fax or e-mail no later than **28<sup>th</sup> February 2019**.

**3.** The competition, unless for the **Piano Performance** section, will articulate in only one test. The execution order will be for draw of the letter.

**4.** Contestants can try grand piano in the timetables established from the organization, kindly granted by *Lazzari pianoforti*.

**5.** The jury, whose judgment is inappellable and unquestionable, will listen to the contestants in alphabetical order after the extraction of the letter carried out from the President, at the end of registrations and for categories; the jury will be able to interrupt the execution in case it exceeds the concurred time or to call supplementary tests. To the members of jury is not allowed to have own students and teachers will have also to grant appropriate declaration before the beginning of the competition.

**6.** The jury will be able to reserve the faculty not to assign the prizes.

7. The contestants cannot encamp no right on the eventual wireless or television recordings of their competition included the final concert of the winners.

8. Diplomas and the relative prizes will have to be withdrawn in the days of development of the competition and they will not be sent.

9. The results, with the relatives prizes, will be communicated at the end of the auditions of each category. The prizes will be awarded by the authorities invited during the Gala Evening, in which the winners is required to perform with the program chosen by the Commission, under penalty of loss of the prize. The final evening is scheduled for **7.00 pm on March 16<sup>th</sup> 2019** at the **Laboratorio Urbano of Fasano**.

10. During the competition, all the participants and their families will be able to benefit from a convention regarding hotel services. For any reservations refer to the facilities that have a tariff agreement.

11. The Association declines every responsibility regarding eventual damages that the contestants had to bring back or to cause during the development of the competition. For any controversy the index hole is Brindisi.
